Goat heads, dual semiparalel chanter, flea-hole type of bagpipe. The called "palóc bagpipe" is the most striking characteristic of the type that chanter a carved wooden goat or ram fits, and sometimes chanter of forming a so-called half-tones. Flea hole will also be constructed.
